The Secretary's report was read and approved w/ a motion by Sheila Holland and a Seconded by Marv Nysetvold. Voted on and passed.

The Treasures report, was given w/ a balance of \$5,621.31. The treasures report was approved w/ a motion by Randy Martin and Seconded by Tera Gilbertson.

Old Business - Dikes Project – The County Commissioners had asked Randy Groves when the start date for the road project was going to be and he reported back the Start of June. **Tree dump** – In a effort to expand the possibilities of an area to be found for a Tree dump, we should also be looking at residential areas along w/ commercial.

New Business – Minnesota Lakes and Rivers Association – Dues are up for renewal, it is a state wide organization that helps local lake associations. Trevor will send out the info they've been sending to see if we'd like to renew. The cost is \$375.00. **Casey Jones Trail Association** – Dues are up for this organization as well, at a cost of \$50.00. a motion was made by Tera Gilbertson and seconded by Sheila Holland to renew. Voted on and passed. **Trees-** It was discussed if replanting trees could be done after the dike's road was finalized. It was thought that was something we'd be in favor of doing or helping with. Additionally, there was discussion of putting up or sponsoring benches along the walk path. Maybe at that point Murray County Soil and Water or Barstad's could help w/ tree availability. **Annual meeting** – We should start putting out a message of how many positions are up for election. It was thought 3, we can confirm this and put a message out on facebook, so people interested could get us their info. **Speakers/ Content** – Could Jean Christoffels be at meeting or put together for us to present a "5 common questions or concerns" in regards to zoning laws and ordinances. The U of M could also provide us w/ some info from their study for us to present as well, if no one was available to attend. Another idea for a speaker was Katie Chapman to talk about the Keep it Clean program, and water quality. **Extra lodging on lots** – The topic of having extra campers, temporary lodging etc. On lots and the extra load on the sewer system was brought up. Could those places be asked to pay, for example a \$10 maintenance fee to offset the extra wear and tear on the grinder pumps etc.? How would the logistics of that work?
