Of the over 700 sewer hook ups only 250 are classified as permanent residents. This may make the lakes area difficult to become un incorporated if it ever decided to pursue that. **Dumpsters** - Brandon reported that the response to the dumpsters has been very positive and appreciated.

New Business – Marshes landing parking – Trevor Humphrey talked to Justin Hoffman of Murray County Parks in regards to parking at Marshes Landing. Ideas of moving dumpsters and the recycling shed were discussed. Also, the idea of flattening out the 2 mounds was discussed, but it was thought that an archeological study may have to be done to ensure there is no buried artifacts. **Boat launch** – Justin had informed Trevor that Marshes Landing is scheduled to remove the cement fingers that make up the ramp and get a solid concrete ramp as it's replacement. **U of M** - Trevor signed us up w/ the U of M to continue the zebra mussel testing next summer. **DNR** - Kyle reported that the DNR had some sort of waterfowl project going on on Round Lake, north of Fox Lake.
