

Shetek Area Lake Association Minutes, March 17th 2026

Roll Call – Trevor Humphrey, Marv Nysetvold, Randy Martin, Kyle Krzmarzick, Kris Toner, Jon Hoyme, Brandon Sonstegard, Steve Koch.

The Secretary's report was read and approved w/ a motion by Steve Koch and a Seconded by Marv Nysetvold. Voted on and passed.

The Treasures report, was given w/ a balance of \$5,232.71. A motion to pay an incoming bill of \$350.00 for our annual web site fee, to DigiKor, was made by Randy Martin and Seconded by Marv Nysetvold. Voted on and passed. The treasures report was approved w/ a motion by Kyle Krzmarzick and seconded by Steve Koch Voted on and passed.

Old Business – City incorporating - Steve relayed some more in-depth info on the initial steps of becoming unincorporated. A petition has to be signed by 100 Property owners. A 9-person board has to be formed to become a Body of Authority. A Chief Administrative judge has to approve of that, and surrounding townships need to be notified within 30 days of the board's intentions. A judge then holds a public hearing in Minneapolis, where board members state their case. At that point a 2nd approval process would be made at a cost anywhere from \$180,000 - \$800,000. All sewer hookups (not just permanent) would pay in. **Zoom Meeting equipment** - Upgraded audio/video equipment ranges from \$1,000 for an "Owl" to \$250 for a more basic system that doesn't turn to the person speaking. A motion was made to try the \$250 system by Steve Koch and seconded by Brandon Sonstegard. Voted on and passed.

Annual meeting – Topics for the annual meeting were discussed. They involved A road report, winter / summer dumpster info, zoom meeting info, Website auto pay, info on Casey Jones trail group, and joining the "Keep it Clean" program.

New Business – Red Rock Rural Water – Gave Trevor a timeline of the end of summer for having Lake Sarah Township done. **Summer dumpsters** – Randy brought up the idea of having the dumpsters at the boat launches because of the success they had for winter. Also, would it work to have garbage's on the dikes? They'd have to be anchored down somehow. Would they get mis used? It was thought the best thing would be to talk to Schaap Sanitation to see if they had any ideas. It was also noted how bad the recycling shed is after a busy weekend.
