The Secretary's report was read and approved w/ a motion by Steve Koch and a Seconded by Marv Nysetvold. Voted on and passed.

Old Business – Zoom equipment – Nothing has been ordered yet. **Dikes Project** – Replanting of trees? Randy Groves did not have any info on if trees would be getting replanted. Mark Carlson was going to follow up w/ him.

New Business – Annual meeting – There will be 4 spots on the ballot this yr. Randy Martin, Marv Nysetvold, Steve Koch, and one open spot for Sheila Holland who resigned. **Possible speakers** of Nick Demuth from the historical society and Janet Timmerman who published a book about the Lake Shetek area were mentioned. **Meeting topics** – A discussion could be had on common County zoning issues around the lake for example shed sizes, and variances and ADU's (Accessory Dwelling Units) which limit residence to seasonal campers. It was discussed to have a suggestion box put up for people to write comments of topics for the group to address. Papers to advertise in included: Tracy Headlight, Wheel Herald, Marshall Independent, and the Fulda Free Press. **Debit Card** - With the zoom account and other annual billings, the SALA group discussed getting a debit card. A motion was made by Brandon Sonstegard and Seconded by Steve Koch to have the SALA group apply for and get a Debit card to be used on zoom account billings and other bills. Voted on and passed. **Light House Lane**- It was brought up that there is concern by residence of Light House Lane of lots w/ only storage sheds getting built vs. a residence.
